RESEARCH AND SCHOLARSHIP

Statement of Research Focus

My research and scholarship has focused on two major interrelated themes: (a) how the *structure and nature of knowledge production and dissemination* in sport management impacts the field and stakeholders in it, and (b) how *stakeholder interests* are impacted by the cultures, structures, and processes within various sport management contexts. The overarching goal of this research agenda has been to understand, interrogate, and challenge the ways in which sport management research, education, and practice impacts a myriad of stakeholder groups, particularly members of marginalized racial groups. I consider myself to be a critical-interpretivist research scholar who primarily utilizes qualitative inquiry to study issues pertaining to race, diversity, equity, and justice in the field of sport management. Some examples of the types of questions my interdisciplinary work seeks to address includes: How do organizational processes contribute to the maintenance of racial domination and stratification? To what extent is race built into the definition of a sport manager? How are societal race relations reproduced in sport organizations and the academy? How does race and racial identity affect organizational experiences? How does race fit into and inform discussions of diversity (management) in the field?
